KNOWN CREWMEMBERS (US)

KCM is the system used to provide efficient authentication for airline crew members in the United States. Companies can register their employees after providing significant identification data to the TSA.

KCM was recently breached after an SQL injection attack was performed on a trusted third party.

ASIC CARDS (AU)

ASIC cards are photo cards issued by any of 13 companies across Australia.

However, these cards have a single hologram, and are printed in monochrome on the rear. The holograms can be bought from AliExpress in 100-packs.



RESTRICTED AREA IDENTITY CARDS (CA)

Canadian RAICs are ID cards which embed biometric data, such as fingerprints and iris scan information.

These cards implement multi-factor authentication, but still use a walled garden approach to aviation security.
